We guarantee a friendly and communicative environment, combined with efficient and varied instruction.

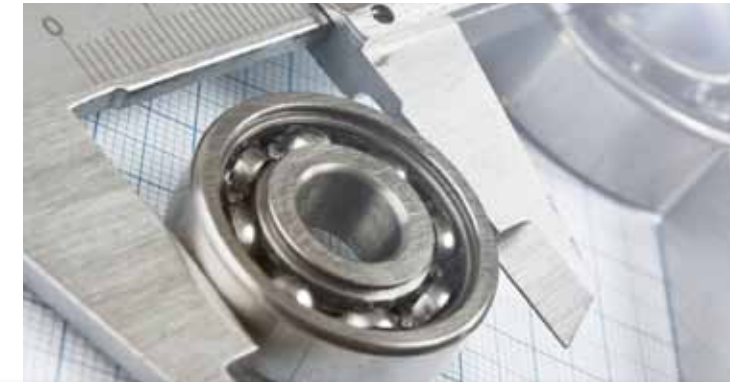
The central location of the Goethe-Institut Hamburg at the main station along the city's "art mile" offers excellent transport links by train, bus, underground or S-Bahn rail network.

CREATING TECHNOLOGY MANAGERS

Since 1998, the Northern Institute of Technology Management (NIT), in cooperation with the Technical University of Hamburg-Harburg, has offered a double degree program taught in English language. Unique to Europe, this program brings students, which are especially talented, together from all over the world to complete a Master of Science in Engineering and a Master of Business Administration (MBA) in Technology Management within a two year period. Alternatively, the Master of Technology Management (MTM) can be absolved.

Especially attractive – most of the tuition fees and the rent for the on-campus apartments within the NIT building are covered by industry-sponsored scholarships. DOUBLE QUALIFICATION

Participants in the double degree program divide their attention between the Technical University Hamburg-Harburg and the NIT equally. At the Technical University they choose their desired engineering discipline from 27 Master programs. The professors and faculty conduct lectures and educational activities based on an interdisciplinary approach with an applied and theoretical research orientation.

The management education takes place at the NIT. In addition to excellence in managerial disciplines, NIT places extraordinary focus on the areas of ethics, communication, and foreign languages. Domestic, as well as foreign lecturers conduct the program with the most up-to-date learning and educational methods. Professors, industry professionals and coaches motivate the students, which stem from over 20 countries, to develop themselves personally and attain new levels of performance. They are able to illustrate their abilities in an internship, a Project Work ("Studienarbeit") focusing on applied theory and two Master Thesis. The topics are usually chosen and developed together with the sponsors and then carried out within the company.
